INTRODUCTION

Enjoy zodiac rides through icy bays and beach landings where you should see large colonies of penguins close-up, all while traveling in luxury and comfort. ITINERARY

DAY 1: Depart Punta Arenas, Chile

Sail along the Strait of Magellan towards Cape Froward, the southernmost tip of the American landmass, and continue south.





DAY 2: Explore Southern Patagonia

Escorted by Peale's dolphins, the ship will navigate along the Glacier Alley, offering an opportunity for a Zodiac excursion at the Garibaldi Glacier.



After spending some free time in Ushuaia, the ship sets sail along the Beagle channel towards Antarctica.

DAY 4: Crossing the Drake passage - Day 4 & 5

Sail the Drake Passage and reach the South Shetland Islands in Antarctica.

DAY 6: Explore Antarctica - Day 6 to 8

Cruise between the South Shetland Islands and the western coast of the Antarctic Peninsula, sailing along ice-filled fjords and among spectacular icebergs. Each day, disembark by Zodiac and explore the landscape. The Expedition Team sets the voyage route to take advantage of the ever-changing opportunities provided by Nature, crafting a unique and extraordinary experience on each landing.








DAY 9: Scheduled return flight from Antarctica
